THE 27TH INTERNATIONAL SLAVONIC COLLOQUIUM
TO HONOUR THE SLAVS' SAINTS CYRIL AND METHODIUS

The conference will include the following panels:

- 1. The tradition of Saints Cyril and Methodius in the social development of the Slavs.*
- 2. Slavonic histories, languages, literatures and cultures: conceptual issues.*
- 3. Ukraine and the Ukrainians in the Slavonic and European Contexts.*
- 4. Historiography and methodology of Slavonic Studies.*

The colloquium will include the issues about **Western and Southern Slavs, their connections with Ukraine and the Ukrainians** as well as about **the history of Slavonic Studies**. The official conference languages will be all Slavonic languages. The application form may be sent by **30 April 2019**. The Committee reserves the right to reject the topics that do not meet the aim of the colloquium. Correspondence participation in the colloquium is not allowed.

After delivering their reports, all participants of the colloquium should hand the panel chairperson the abstract of their reports (up to 4000 characters with spaces), which are necessary for composing the final account of the Conference.

The texts of some reports (0.5 up to 1 printing sheet) **if agreed by the editorial board**, may be published in the academic journal *Problemi slovianoznavstva* / Problems of Slavonic Studies.
