- 3. Ukraine and the Ukrainians in the Slavonic and European Contexts.*
- 4. Historiography and methodology of Slavonic Studies.*

The colloquium will include the issues about Western and Southern Slavs, their connections with Ukraine and the Ukrainians as well as about the history of Slavonic Studies.

Aiming at popularising the Slavonic studies among young people, during the colloquium there will be a student section. Both students of the higher educational institutions from Ukraine and abroad, whose fields of interest will be researched at the colloquium, are encouraged to participate.

Working languages – Ukrainian, all West Slavic and South Slavic languages, English. The applications should be submitted by April 28, 2026 to **kolokviumlviv@gmail.com**. The Committee reserves the right to reject the topics that do not meet the aim of the colloquium.
